We have rules, regulations and expectations posted, please read them. The Onset Campgrounds shall not be liable for any personal injury, damage to or loss of licensee s property in, on or about the premises even if said damage or injuries are alleged to be the fault of or caused by negligence or carelessness of the Onset Campgrounds.

A FEW SIMPLE RULES:

- You may access your property during the winter; just let someone know you are there.
- The water will be shut off after October 15th to prevent freezing and breaking of the pipes.
- We do not provide snow removal to the camping area.
- We have provided excellent bathroom facilities and expect them to be kept clean.
- Put your trash barrels marked with your name, on Zarahemla Ave. on Wednesday trash day.
- Campsites and grounds will be kept clean.
- Dogs will be kept on a leash (Town Law).
- One vehicle at campsite, others will be parked at the ballfield.
- No loud noise after 10:00PM
- There are no sewage hook-ups; there is a dump station and bathrooms.
- No open fires. Cooking fires only are allowed per order of the Fire Department.
- All units must be removed prior to Memorial Day Weekend unless the owners have already completed a contract for the upcoming season that begins on Memorial Day (units cannot remain on site if the contract does not begin on Memorial Day) or they will be removed at the owner s expense.

Clarification for the above rule: If you have stored your unit all winter and have a contract for the Memorial Day Weekend, then you may leave your unit on site till after the end of your contract. If you have stored your unit all winter and you have a contract for the Fourth of July Weekend, then you must vacate the site, before Memorial Day, until your contract begins.
